Sorry, it seems I didn't explain it correctly.

The upstart config is there:

```
# readlink -f openvz.conf  
/mnt/data/vz/private/2094/etc/init/openvz.conf
```

Since that has no effect at all, I've tried to run the script contents manually using `vzctl exec`. So I've created a file in `/etc/init.d/vz` and made it executable so I could run it:

```
vzctl start 2094  
vzctl exec 2094 /etc/init.d/vz
```

That works just fine. The VE continues to start and after a minute I can enter the VE and also the services have been started.

So I've tried another thing:

```
#vzctl restart 2094  
#vzctl exec 2094 ls -l /proc  
total 0
```

So the issue seems to be clear, `/proc` isn't mounted.

Yes, I can mount it manually with `vzctl exec`, but that's still not a nice solution.
