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You must create a centos-add_ip.sh script with code that creates the correct files in your centos template. I don't know anything about centos, so I can't help there. In the meanwhile I did something similar for Arch Linux which had also the strange and unnecessary venet0:0.

After creating the script, you change the centos.conf to use your new script. At the moment it points to a Red Hat script:

ADD_IP=redhat-add_ip.sh
