when you su to root, ensure you use the command:

```
# su -
```

the dash indicates you want to configure your environment for root (and thus its search paths), otherwise, you keep your user account environment configuration, which does not include /sbin.

Another option would be to point to the service executable directory with:

```
# /sbin/service
```
