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Simplest thing is:

```
mkdir /newvz
```

```
mount /dev/sda2 /vz  
mount /dev/sda3 /newvz
```

```
/etc/rc.d/init.d/vz stop
```

```
cd /vz  
find . -print | cpio -pvdm ../newvz
```

```
when it's done,  
umount /vz  
umount /newvz
```

```
mount /dev/sda3 /vz  
/etc/rc.d/init.d/vz start
```

THEN MAKE SURE YOU EDIT /etc/fstab

With this approach, you will still have your data on /dev/sda2 if for some reason you messed it up, and you can retrieve it by doing:

```
mkdir /oldvz  
mount /dev/sda2 /oldvz
```
