Hey,

I'm using the Prebuilt RHEL5 Kernel from the Stable OpenVZ branch on my Debian Squeeze.

<http://wiki.openvz.org/Download/kernel/rhel5/028stab091.1>

Download the right rpm according to your system and install it with `alien -i /path/to/my/openvz-kernel.rpm`. Alien will complain about missing Signatures, you can ignore that.

Afterwards run `update-initramfs -k 2.6.18-238.12.1.el5.028stab091.1` (correct it with your downloaded kernel-version) and afterwards `update-grub` to let grub know the new Kernel+Initrd.

All you need to do know is reboot and make sure it boots in the right Kernel (maybe set a default-bootoption in grub or else...)
