Hi,

Quick question for you.

I have a Dell PowerEdge 1950 III 2x Quad Core E5450 3.00Ghz 16GB RAM 146GB PERC6 Server.

This server will be used primarily for web hosting via WHM/cPanel and also 2nd for selling VPS via OpenVZ.

I understand the preferred method to install is: Install CentOS minimal on hardware node > Install OpenVZ > Create a VPS > Install WHM/cPanel on the VPS.

Now my question is what SPECS do I give my main master VPS that will be running all of the web hosting? Can I tell it to use all available recourses?

I only ask this as i fear running all of my web hosting from one VPS may bottle neck the system?

Would you recommend installing WHM/cPanel before OpenVZ so WHM/cPanel can take advantage of the full hardware capabilities?
