Well... I meant slightly different scenario:

On host node you are mounting autofs on, say,
/mnt/nfsshare/nfs1, /mnt/nfsshare/nfs2, etc.

Then do

```
mount --bind /mnt/nfsshare/nfs1/ /vz/root/100/home/
```

```
mount --bind /mnt/nfsshare/nfs2/ /vz/root/101/home/
```

....

I suppose, appropriate nfs mount will be automounted only when you are using /home inside appropriate VE and automatically unmounted after some time... Well, usual autofs.

However, it might not work for various reasons:

- 1) --bind "get" nfs and it is always mounted
- 2) atomounter don't receive a "signal" from VE to mount an NFS partition (this is very probably).

So, it's necessary to check all these stuff!

If you'll do it - please post your results here.

I'll try to do something like that in the near future...
