Hi,

vzpid - display the VE ID given the process ID (PID)

vzpid <pid_of_process> -> shows the VEID running !

example :

ps -C cron

Shows me all pids of crons

PID	TTY	TIME	CMD
2613	?	00:00:00	cron
4132	?	00:00:00	cron
4511	?	00:00:00	cron
31090	?	00:00:00	cron
18493	?	00:00:00	cron
29251	?	00:00:00	cron
14539	?	00:00:00	cron

which VE has the cron daemon with pid 18493

vzpid 18493

Pid	VEID	Name
18493	<VEID>	cron

But if you need all pids of a VE:

Scan all "status" files in /proc/<pid>/ the entry:
(its the same what vzpid do!)

example (with settings above!)

```
grep 'envID:' /proc/18493/status  
envID: <VEID>
```

Or you can use the vzproc-tools (top), but you need to compile it yourself (
