a look to the man page of vzctl shows me that the "ipt\_MASQUERADE" is not in the IPTABLES MODULE LIST!

So you can't use the module ipt\_MASQUERADE!

--iptables name

Restrict access to iptables modules inside a VE (by default all iptables modules that are loaded in the host system are accessible inside a VE).
