>> In recent 2.6 kernels (2.6.16+) netfilter code is changed by new

>> x\_tables

>> (Abstraction layer for {ip,ip6,arp}\_tables). This patch updates iptables

>> wrapper code in vzctl for this changes (adding xt\_tcpudp support).

> xt\_tcpudp previously were inside ip\_tables module. So, for compatibility,

> current kernels handles this module by VE\_IP\_IPTABLES mask.

But this module isn't been autoloaded. Let's try service vz start, and see that xt\_tcpudp is absent. So looks like it ovz kernel patch bug.
