The point is that privvmpages held is how much memory applications in VE have allocated. But they don't use all the this memory in fact! Experience says, that most of the programmes use only 10-30% of memory they've allocated. Thus, privvmpages limit is a limit for allocation, while oomguarpages is a limit for real physical memory used by VE.
